Especially at Prom and Graduation season, TEAM Georgia and QuikTrip are spreading the word about Safe Driving to teenagers in Georgia.

Traffic crashes are the leading cause of death for teenagers. Here in Georgia, more than 130 teens, ages 16 to 18, died in traffic crashes last year. In Georgia in 2005, there were 105 fatalities associated with 98 crashes where teens (ages 15 through 17) were drivers. These fatalities break down as follows: 21 were teen passengers, 39 were teen drivers, 1 teen pedestrian and 44 were non-teens. Additionally, in 2005, teen drivers were associated with: 28,655 crashes and 8,402 injuries.

Our Message is Simple:

*"How many of your friends or classmates have to be injured or killed?
The choices you make can change the trend and save your life."*

It's Illegal to:

- Drive while impaired by drugs or alcohol
- Drive or ride in a vehicle without a seat belt
- Drink if you are under age 21
- Drive at an illegal or unsafe speed
- Have an open container in the vehicle
- Possess alcohol if you are under age 21

Class D (Provisional license for Class C vehicles)

- May not operate between 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m.
- During six-month period immediately following issuance of such license any Class D license holder shall not drive when any passenger in the vehicle is not a member of driver's immediate family.
- For the duration of the Class D, license holders shall not drive when more than three passengers in the vehicle are less than 21 years of age. (Members of the driver's immediate family do not count).
