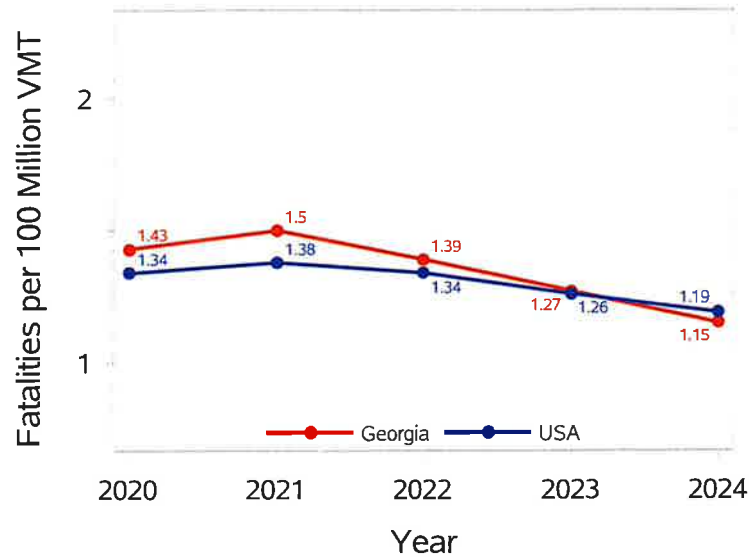

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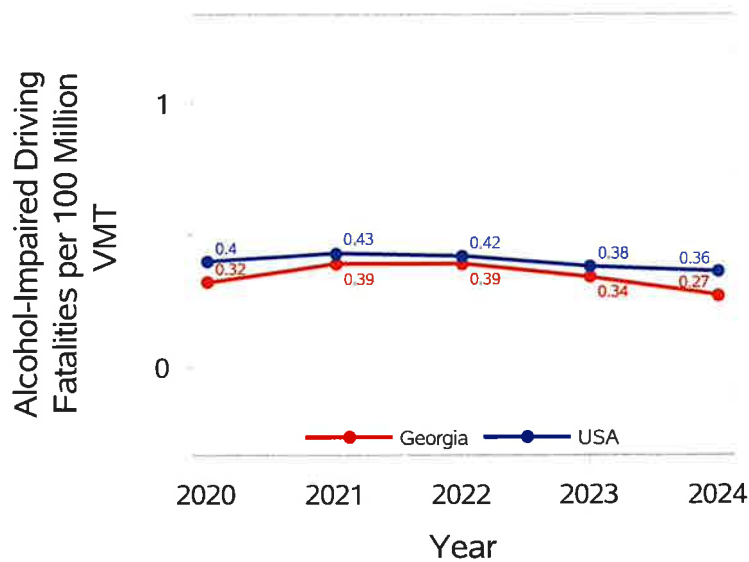


Fatalities per 100 Million VMT

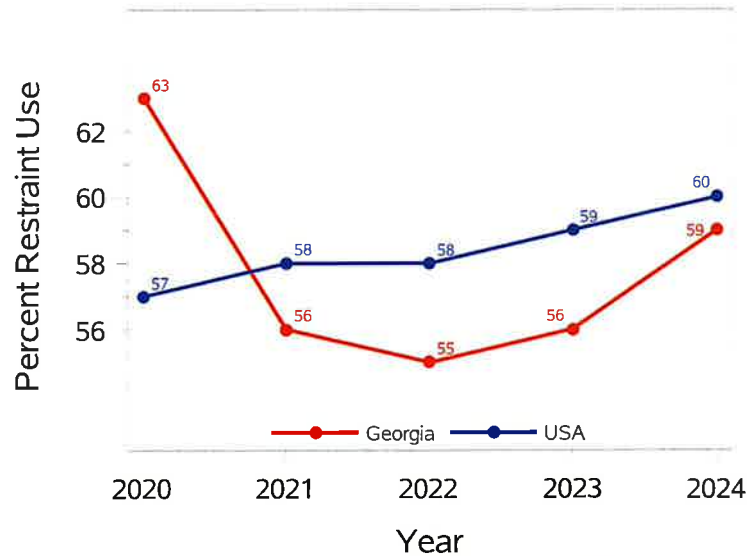

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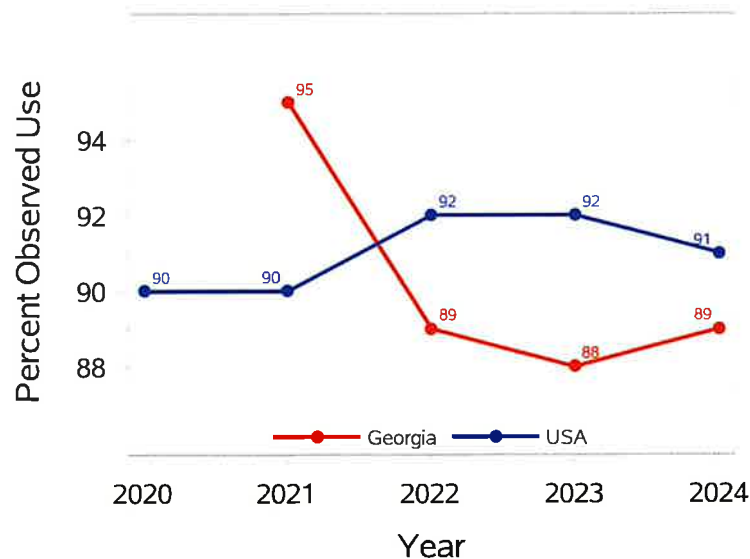
Daytime Front Seat (Outboard Only) Passenger Vehicle Occupant Fatalities,

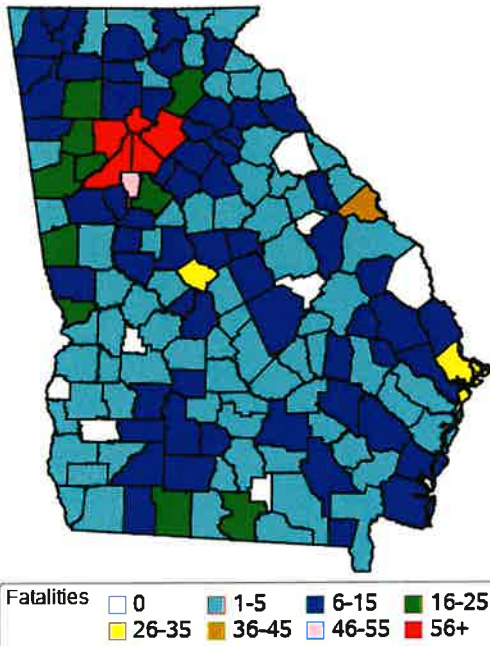

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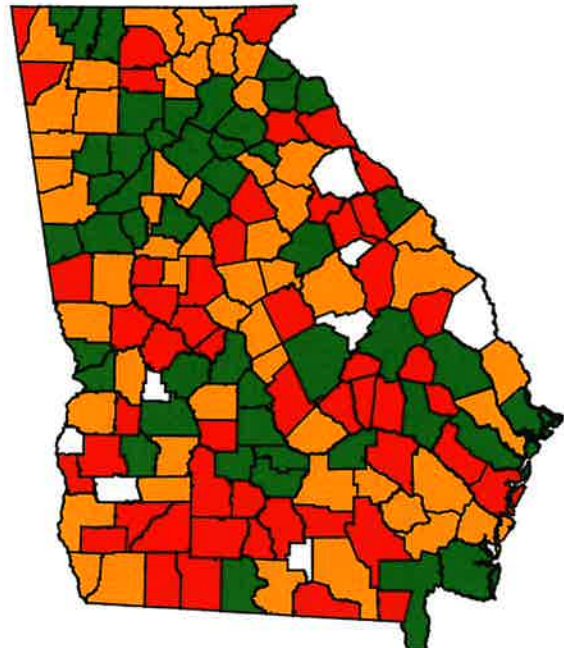


Georgia Motor Vehicle Crash Fatality Maps for 2024

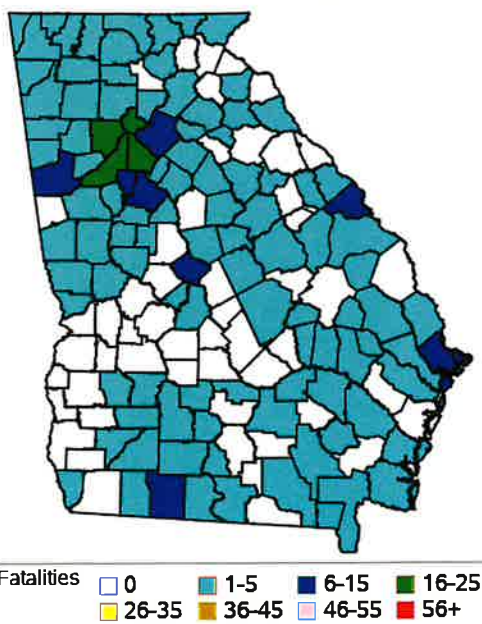

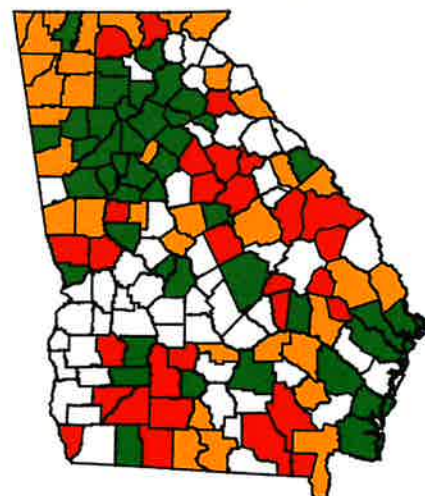
Fatalities (All Crashes) per 100,000 Population

Fatalities in Crashes Involving an Alcohol-Impaired Driver (BAC = .08+) per 100,000 Population

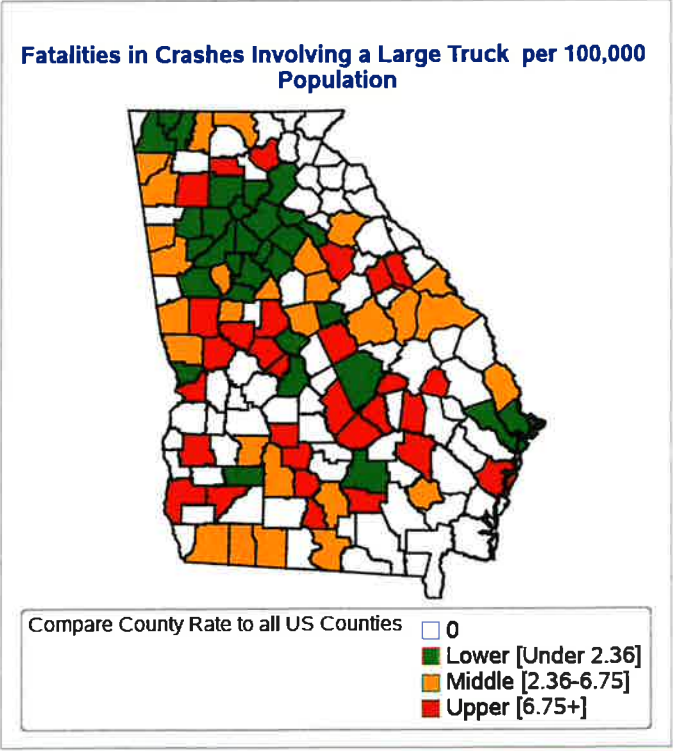
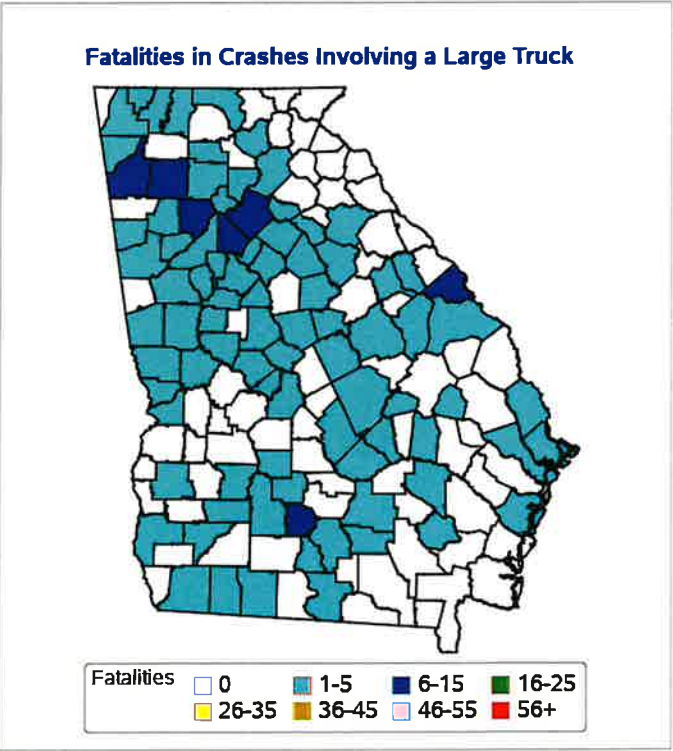
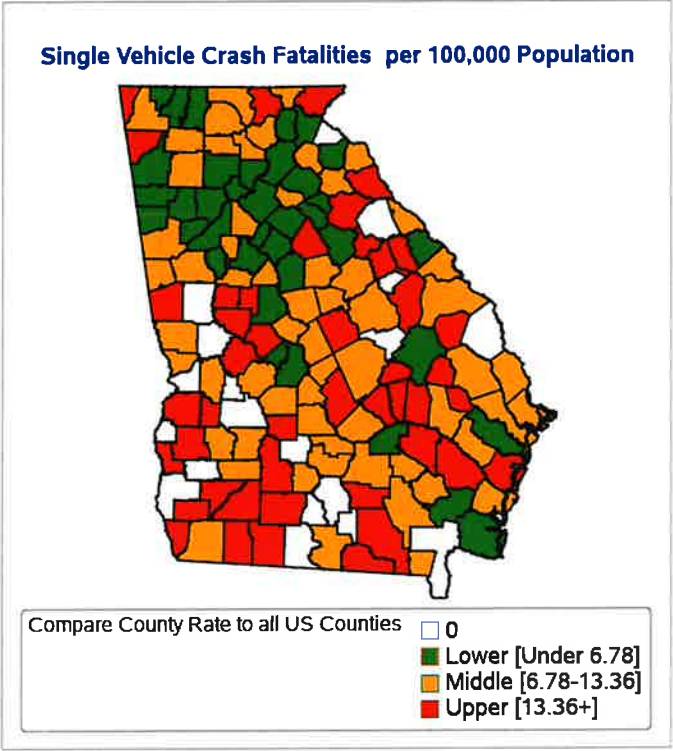
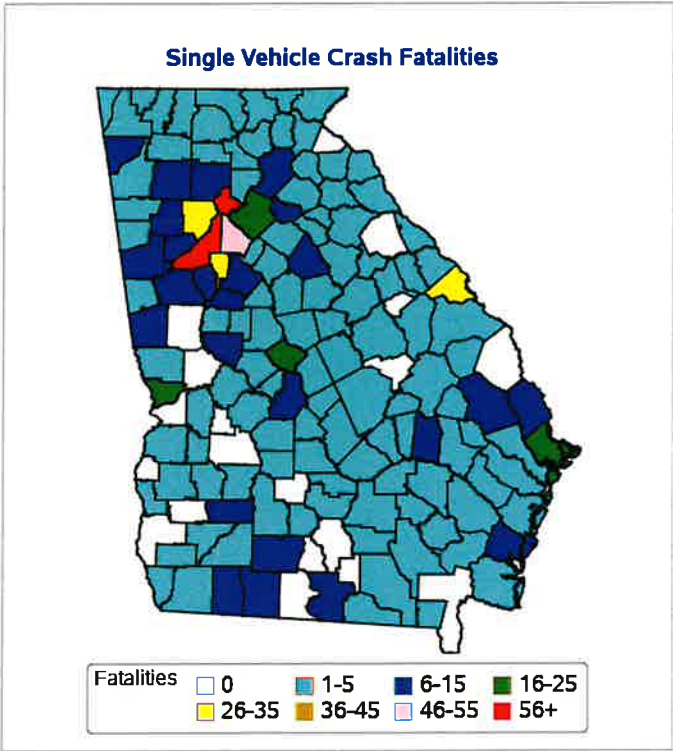

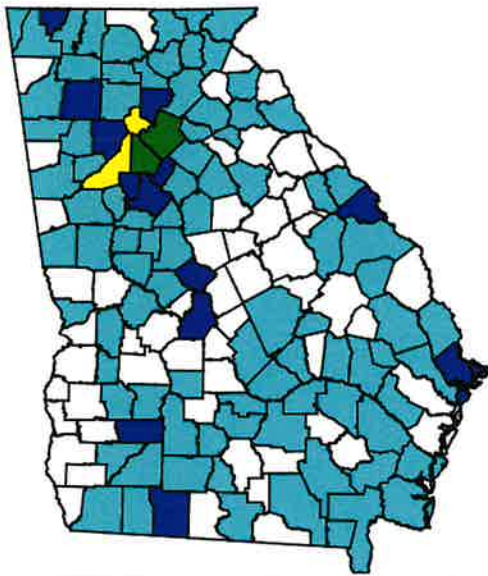

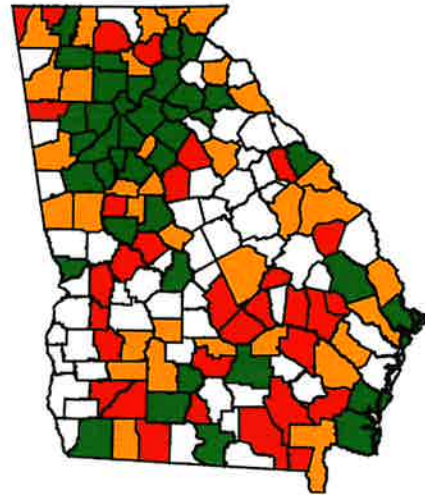

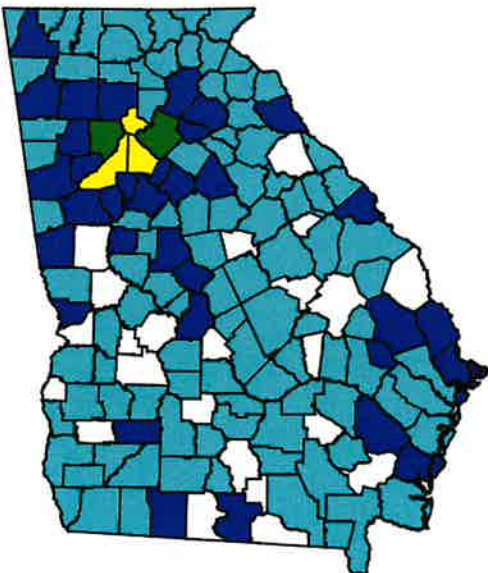
Fatalities in Crashes Involving Speeding per 100,000 Population

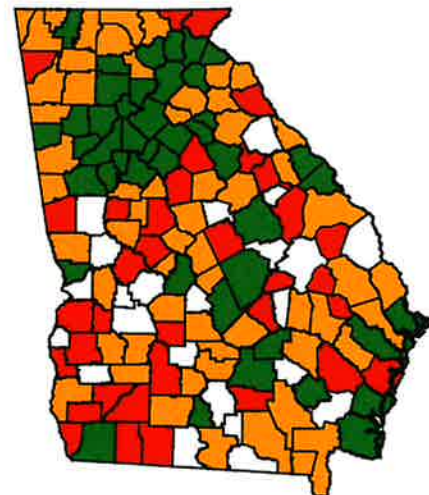
Fatalities in Crashes Involving a Roadway Departure

Fatalities in Crashes Involving a Roadway Departure per 100,000 Population



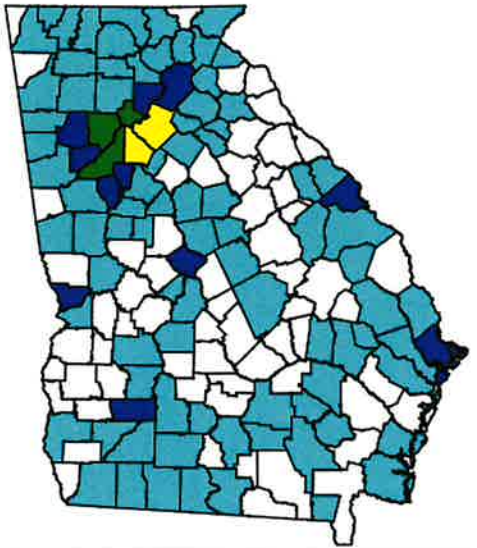

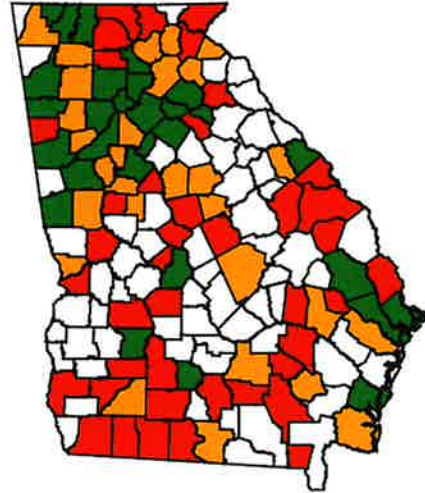

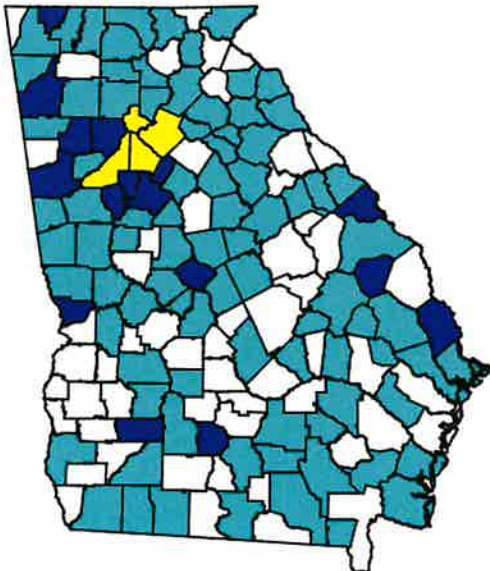
Fatalities in Crashes Involving an Intersection (or Intersection Related) per 100,000 Population

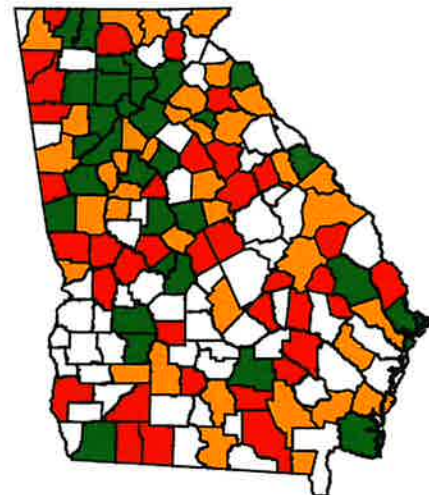

Passenger Car Occupant Fatalities per 100,000 Population



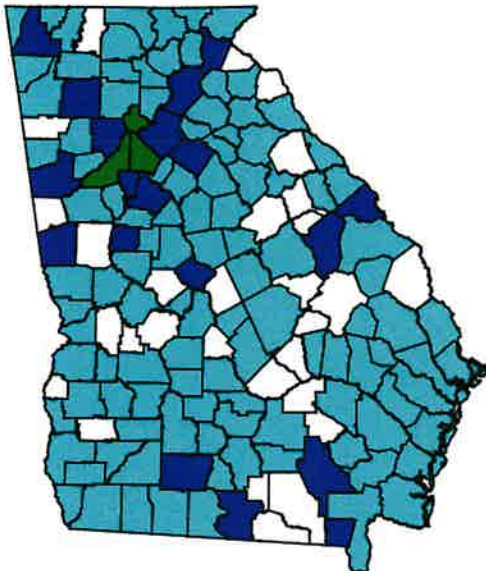

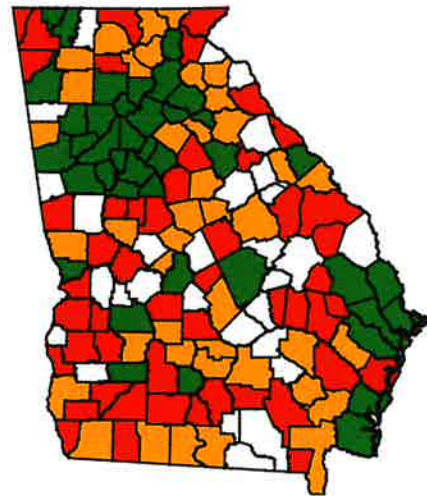

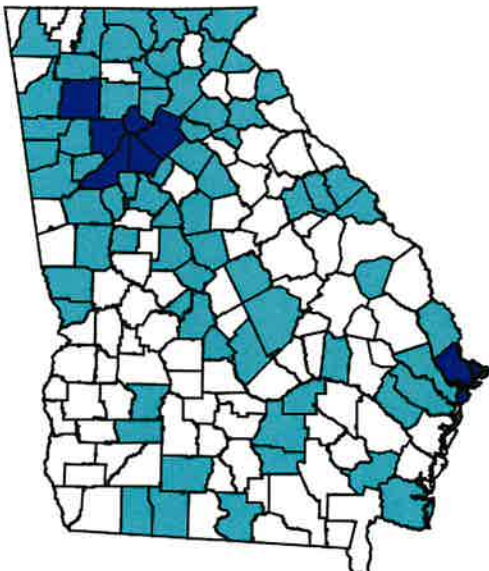
Light Truck and Van Occupant Fatalities per 100,000 Population

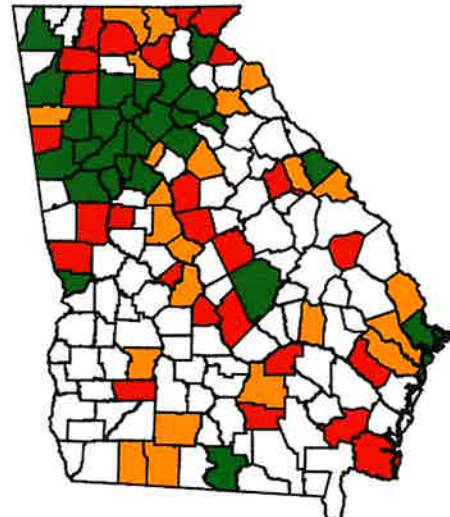

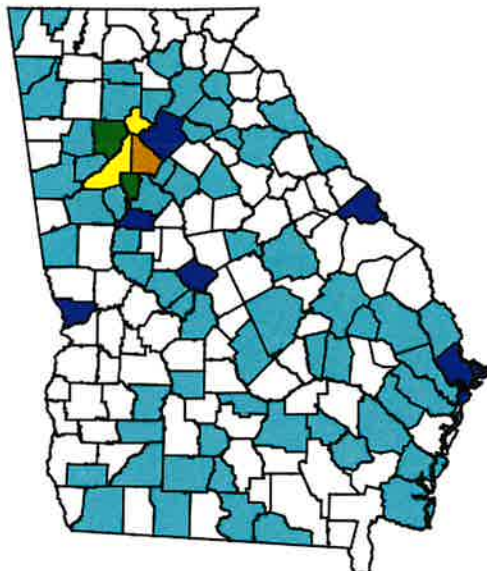

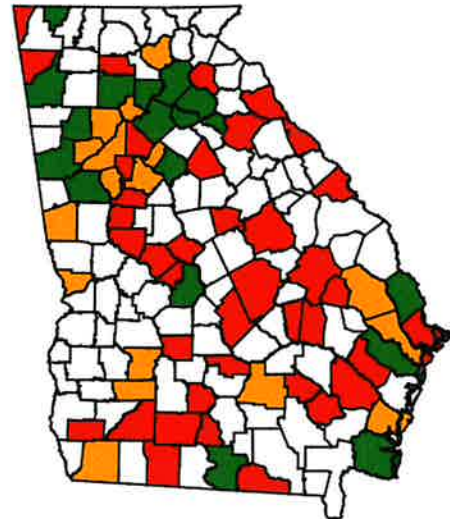

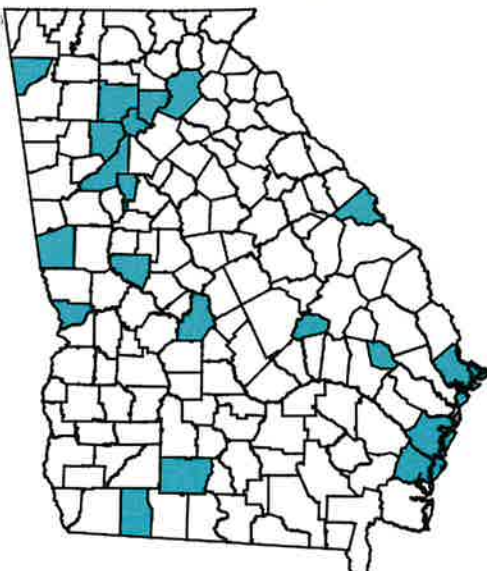
Pedestrian Fatalities per 100,000 Population

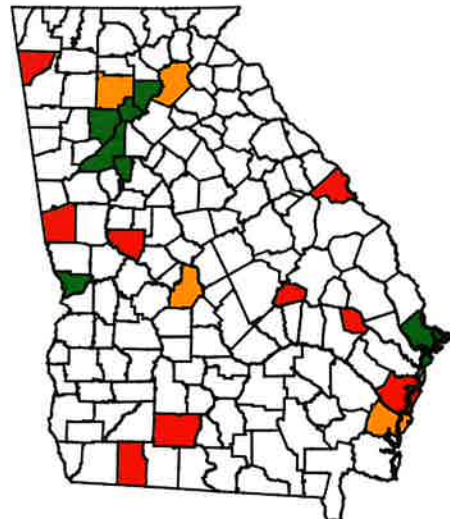
