



## CONCLUSIONS

With the Governor's SHSP, Georgia's highway safety goals are more clearly defined. Measurable lifesaving strategies contribute to specific highway safety areas to achieve the desired, lifesaving outcomes. Existing highway safety plans and organizational contributions are aligned to leverage existing resources. The results are Georgia's annual highway fatalities continue to decline. Georgia evaluates its progress using three-year averages through 2015. Georgia will review the statewide annual fatality reduction goal every three years. The 2014 annual highway fatality total should close out under previous year's 1,180. And, Georgia continues to "strive for zero deaths and injuries on Georgia roads."
